The 14,000-square-foot facility includes four exhibit halls that offer the opportunity to showcase special exhibits, two multi-purpose rooms, a lobby, shop, resource centre and storage for over 25,000 artifacts and historical treasures.

More importantly, it enables the museum to showcase blockbuster exhibitions from around the globe, such as the current Rock and Roll Hall of Fame *Part of the Machine* exhibit. "We are the first Canadian facility to host this exhibit, I want to thank TD Bank for its sponsorship," added John.
